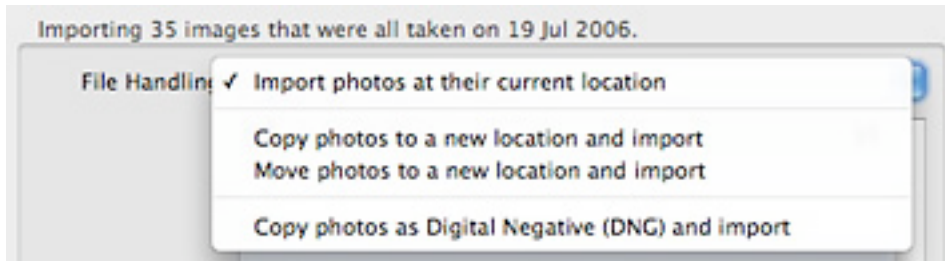


## Import Options

**What's the difference between 'Import photos at their current location', 'Copy', 'Move', and 'Copy as DNG'?**



'Import photos at their current location' leaves the files in their current folder structure with their existing file names, and references them in that location.

'Copy photos to a new location and import' copies the files to a folder of your choice, leaving the originals untouched. It gives you additional options on the folder structure and allows you to rename when you import.

'Move photos to a new location and import' offers the same options as 'Copy' but removes the files from their original location.

'Copy photos as Digital Negative (DNG) and import' offers the same options as 'Copy', leaves the originals untouched, but also converts the files to DNG format while importing.
