Shift - Select or deselect multiple consecutive items. (Library, select multiple images, select multiple folders, select multiple keywords etc)					
Alt - Changes the use of some controls to alternative uses. (Quick Develop, swaps Clarity and Vibrance for Sharpening and Saturation. Other panels, changes auto button to reset button. On opening LR, giv
